
I would like to encourage EVAW Coalition members to apply to the London Community Response Fund. We know that organisations need help now and while the Mayor may get a positive response to our request, we have two emergency funding programmes that are taking applications in response to this situation:

- **Crisis response** – grants of up to £10,000 that can be back-dated to 23rd March 2020
- **Delivering differently** – grants of between £10,000 and £50,000 to enable services to change the way service are delivered
